Ministry Purpose / Objective:

To oversee the visual atmosphere of the church during the liturgical year.

General Responsibilities of All Ministry Members:

- Discerns God's message in one's own life regarding stewardship of Time, Talent and Treasure.
- Is familiar with any Ministry and Diocesan guidelines as well as General Parish Procedures.
- Presents ministry in a positive light at all times.

Responsibilities of Art & Environment Members:

- Completes necessary tasks that are needed to enhance the visual atmosphere of the church achieved through the minister's abilities, such as sewing, painting, flower arranging, banner making, and other creative skills.
- Maintains availability to provide physical labor during preparation of church décor when appropriate to liturgical season.
- Is familiar with ministry guidelines.
- Watering of plants and flowers in the church and Gathering Area.

Special Activities:

- Attends an initial orientation/training session.
- Any meetings at discretion of coordinator.

Meetings:

- Attend annual ministry meeting.
- Attends additional meetings as necessary according to coordinator.
