Matt Simms brought the meeting to order at 8:45 and Julie shared her opening prayer. September meeting minutes were approved.

More than <u>five hundred</u> parishioners attend the Homecoming event which was a great success. <u>34 Time and Talent sheets</u> were submitted, and it was agreed we will look forward to planning another such event.

Father John invited Marie MacDonald to attend the meeting. She has a Human Resources background. She guided the council as they discussed the Commissions and Committee organizations roles and ministry.

Discussion topics

- At present 26 Ministry Coordinators do not have an Assistant Coordinator
- It may be time to review the purpose and scope of the ministries
- There appears to be limited contact between Coordinators and those who serve in their ministries
- All ministry members should have copies of their ministry guidelines
- How to avoid ministry members being discouraged or burn out
- Are ministry coordinators reaching out to new parishioners who indicated an interest in a specific ministry

There was an in-depth discussion with regard to *one-to-one* contact between coordinators and ministry members, sufficient/ongoing training and follow up. The Usher and Lector ministries have been recruiting new members with on-to-one contact.

Ministries may need a neutral person to review and advise how the ministry is working, this would assist ministers in the process of evaluation.

Council members agreed to the need for members to be available to parishioners as ambassadors for the parish with a future notice in the bulletin and name tags to identify PPC members.

It was decided that Fr. John would suggest a date for PPC to meet just to discussion council's approach to the above issues and how to approach all coordinators to improve our Stewardship opportunities.
